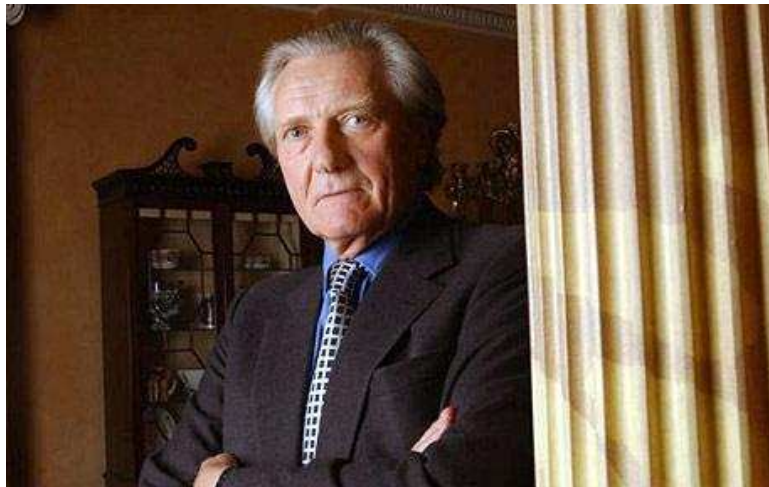




# POST ELECTION PARLIAMENTARY DAY
